WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

WORCESTER, SS.

To either of the Constables of the Town of Clinton in the County of Worcester.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town, qualified to vote in the elections and town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Clinton, on Monday, the fifteenth day of September, 2014 at 7:00 P.M., then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow, transfer from the Stabilization Fund or take from available funds the sum of \$500,000.00, or any other sum, said sum to be expended by the Fire Chief, with approval by the Board of Selectmen, for the purchase of any and all UHF radio equipment needed to replace emergency communications equipment at the Clinton Fire Department, or act in any manner relating thereto.

(Finance Committee – Approved)

ARTICLE 2

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, borrow, transfer from the Stabilization Fund or take from available funds the sum of \$1,000,000.00, or any other sum, said sum to be expended by the Board of Selectmen for all costs associated with centralizing the functions of public safety dispatch communications for the Town of Clinton, or act in any manner relating thereto.

(Finance Committee – Disapproved)

ARTICLE 3

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from the Stabilization Fund or take from available funds the sum of \$14,645.00, or any other sum, said sum to be expended by the Fire Chief as a five percent local match to a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Assistance to Firefighters Grant awarded to the Clinton Fire Department, or act in any manner relating thereto.

(Finance Committee – Approved)

ARTICLE 4

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate from the Ambulance Enterprise Fund the sum of \$300.00, or any other sum, said sum to be expended by the Fire Chief for the purpose of paying the following unpaid bills, or act in any manner relating thereto.

Vital Emergency Medical Services \$300.00

ARTICLE 5

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from the Stabilization Fund or take from available funds the sum of \$165.00, or any other sum, said sum to be expended by the Police Chief for the purpose of paying the following unpaid bill, or act in any manner relating thereto.

Raymond Sauls, M.D. \$165.00

ARTICLE 6

To see if the Town will vote to accept the private way known as Buften Farm Road as a public way in the Town of Clinton, according to a plan on file with the Town Clerk, or act in any manner relating thereto.
