## HELP KEEP FALLEN LEAVES OFF OF TOWN STREETS

Do not blow or rake leaves, grass clippings, brush or tree branches into the street. They may leach nutrients into stormwater runoff and contribute to pollution in our waters. Leaf litter can also plug storm drains and increase flooding. Instead, mulch or compost yard waste away from streams and other waterways, or dispose of these items year round at the Clinton Recycle Center at 99 Woodlawn Street for free.
