

**Selectmen Meeting
Minutes
August 9, 2011**

Selectman Connolly, Selectman Sargent, Selectman LeBlanc, Selectman Dziokonski and Chairman Dickhaut were in attendance. Attendees were Town Solicitor Gibbons and Town Administrator Ward. Chairman Dickhaut opened the meeting at 6:00PM.

Police Relief Association Block Dances

Chairman Dickhaut opened the meeting with discussion regarding the Police Relief Association Block Dances. Chairman Dickhaut explained Town Administrator Ward had spoken to Park & Recreation Director Janda and Chairman of Park & Recreation Commission Verrier for a review of the condition of the park after the dances held recently.
