Town By-law requires property owners to remove snow & ice from sidewalks abutting private property.

A clear sidewalk is good for you and your neighbors!

With a shoveled sidewalk, residents can safely use the sidewalk for winter walks, and school bus stops!

## When you should shovel

Sidewalks adjacent to your property should be cleared within 5 hours after a storm event.

Sand or rock salt should be applied after storm to aid traction and to prevent refreezing.

Clinton Residents may fill pails of sand at no charge at the DPW Gate at 99 Woodlawn St.



## Where you should shovel

Shovel the walkways adjacent to your property.

Please consider shoveling catch basins in front of your property to reduce flooding.

Please shovel nearby fire hydrants to increase access in the event of a fire emergency in your area.
